Cub Scout Programs

For each program, scouts will spend time inside and also explore the habitats outdoors. Badge programs are one-hour long and are scheduled for your group.

Tiger Scouts: Let's Go Outdoors Achievement

Put on your hiking shoes and hit the trail! A naturalist will lead your group on a hike through the forest and then help make leaf rubbings.

Wolf Scouts: Elective 13: Birds

Get some binoculars on and learn about birds first-hand. Scouts will learn to identify birds, help fill the bird feeders, and read a book about birds.

Bear Scouts: Achievement #5: Sharing Your World with Wildlife

Discover what animals share our forests. Scouts will learn about native wildlife and what extinct animals used to live in Indiana, make a poster about an animal, and take a hike to try and spot animals in the wild.

Webelos: Forester Badge

Find out why trees are such an important resource for people and animals. After learning the plant and tree layers in the forest, examining tree growth rings, and discussing the benefits and dangers of forest fires, scouts will head into the forest to learn to identify trees.

Webelos: Naturalist Badge

Get an overview of what plants and animals live in Indiana. Scouts will discover the animals that live in the forests and wetlands of Holliday Park, learn about where birds migrate in the winter, and find out what plants and animals should be treated with caution.

Pricing

Programs are one hour long and \$5/child with a \$50 minimum. There is no fee for adult chaperones. An adult to child ratio of 1:5 is recommended.
