Booking Information

To schedule a program or for additional details on our badge Programs, call the nature center (317) 327-7180. Scout programs are typically scheduled after school during the week and Sunday afternoons. When calling be prepared with the following information:

- 1. Badge/elective or topic
- 2. Date and time, with at least one alternative
- 3. Approximate number of scouts and adults

Program Fees

Programs \$5/scout with a \$50 minimum, chaperones and scout leaders are free. We recommend a ratio of two adults per 15 scouts. *Longer programs available for additional fees.
