To schedule a program or for additional details call the nature center at (317) 327-7180. Programs are typically scheduled on weekdays after school and Sunday afternoons. When calling be prepared with the following information:

1. Badge/petal or topic
2. Date and time, with at least one alternative
3. Approximate number of scouts and adults

Program Fees

Hour-long programs are \$5/scout with a \$50 minimum, chaperones and scout leaders are free. Longer programs are available for additional fees. We recommend a ratio of two adults per 15 scouts, or simply follow the Girl Scout ratio guidelines according to your scouts' level.
