About Holliday Park Nature Discovery Camps

Holliday Park camps offer children a chance to explore nature through hands-on experiences. Each day includes a nature lesson, hike, healthy snack, and craft. Experienced camp counselors maintain a safe environment as they encourage children to enjoy learning and spending time outdoors.

Leaving a voicemail message at the nature center does NOT mean that you are registered for camp. Please call back to reserve your spot.

Fees and Refunds: Fees are due in full upon registration. We accept cash, check (payable to Indy Parks), and all major credit cards.

No cash, credit card, or check refunds. If a request for cancellation is made more than two weeks before the beginning of camp, a credit will be issued to your Indy Parks account, minus a \$15 nonrefundable cancellation fee. *If a camper is withdrawn <u>less than two weeks</u> prior to first day of camp, only 50% of your costs will be credited to your Indy Parks account.* A \$15 fee will be charged when transferring from one camp to another.

Slippery, Slimy Science, May 26-29
