Day 1 – Wednesday, June 1

Meet at the Holliday Inn Express Columbus Downtown

Gardens in Sessions Village - Sessions Village is a French Normandy-inspired community that was created in 1927. The goal as stated in the sales brochure, was to create an "ideal home…where the spirit may grow and the pettiness of the work-a-day world (will) be forgotten in the sanctuary of a garden or the quiet place of a chimney corner." The success of architect Roy Reeves' unique vision was affirmed in the 1975 with Session's Village's inclusion on the U.S. Treasury's National Register of Historic Places. The tour will include five gardens in this small village starting with #21. Members of the Little Flower Club of Columbus will take us through their gardens and lead us to the next one.

Kingwood Center Gardens - Renowned for its distinctive floral displays, unique plant specimens, woodland trails, historic mansion and gardens, display greenhouse, duck pond, and peacocks. Enjoyment and inspiration are assured for horticultural experts, casual gardeners, and nature lovers alike. Unwind, relax, and be restored in the beauty of this exquisite garden estate that once was the home of the innovative industrialist, Charles Kelley King. <u>https://kingwoodcenter.org</u>





Gleaves Garden – Chuck Gleaves, former director of horticulture at IMA and former Director of the Kingwood Center, has spent more than 25 years crafting a wild garden surrounding a farmhouse and barn in the Ohio countryside. Numerous rock walls support a collection of rare and unusual specimens in this passionate plantsman's garden.



German Village - Located just south of downtown Columbus, German Village is one of the most atmospheric neighborhoods in the Midwest. Originally built by German settlers in the mid-1800s, the lovingly restored brick houses, shops, streets and sidewalks are full of historic charm and modern swank. <u>https://germanvillage.com</u>

TERMS: To register for a tour please complete the attached registration form and sign below to acknowledge the terms. Send this form along with your registration form and full tour amount to the Holliday Park Foundation at the address below. Registrations will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis. We will place you on a waiting list if your tour is full.

The full price of this trip is \$500 per participant. Payment and all signed forms are required to secure registration of your spot on the tour. Payment is refundable less a 20% processing fee ONLY if the spot can be filled with another participant at the full tour price. Payments received after the tour has filled will be returned and your name will be placed on a waiting list.

The activity level required for your tour is described in the tour details. If in doubt please contact the Holliday Park Foundation to determine if a tour is right for you. Any physical or medical concerns, including allergies and/or dietary restrictions, should be communicated to the Holliday Park Foundation. All tours will be non-smoking during group activities including but not limited to meals, vehicle travel, and when in close proximity to other participants.

Tours will be held regardless of weather conditions. Severe weather may dictate changes in the itinerary. Tours will begin at scheduled time and tardiness may result in missing arranged transportation.
