SCHEDULING A FIELD TRIP: To schedule a field trip, or for additional information regarding programs offered, call (317) 327-7180. We recommend calling at least one month prior to your desired trip date as the calendar does fill. When calling, be prepared with the following information: Program topic, number of students and adults, and program date, time, and at least one alternative.

PROGRAM FEES: On-site, hour-long field trips are \$5 per student with a \$50 minimum. Parents and chaperones are free, with a suggested adult-to-child ratio of 1:8. Programs are limited to 60 students per hour. Larger groups can be accommodated, please call for details. Schools with a minimum of 40% of students receiving free or reduced lunches are eligible for discounted field-trip fees. Payment is expected in full on the day of the program. Cash, credit, and checks made payable to Indy Parks are accepted.

FIELD TRIP FUNDING: The Holliday Park Foundation, in partnership with the Junior League of Indianapolis. is pleased to offer a funding program that helps cover costs for educators interested in visiting Holliday Park. Funds may be used to cover program fees and transportation. This program fund is designed to distribute funds in amounts up to \$500 so all students in Marion County may have the opportunity to attend Holliday Park programs.
