

About Indy Parks

Indy Parks and Recreation provides parks, greenspaces, trails, and recreation opportunities for Marion County residents and visitors. The agency serves 8 million people annually and offers 217 parks, 11,608 acres of greenspace, 130 playgrounds, 155 sports fields, 153 miles of trails, 23 recreation and nature centers, 20 aquatic centers, 22 spray grounds, 13 golf courses, and four dog parks. Indy Parks also provides more than 2,400 sports, art, education, and recreation programs throughout the year.

General Day Camp Information

The 2026 Indy Parks and Recreation Summer Day Camp program offers a wide variety of opportunities including swimming, arts, nature, science, sports, and recreation. Counselors

All Indy Parks Summer Day Camp counselors are over the age of 16 and participate in more than 30 hours of training before camp begins. All counselors are CPR and First Aid certified and have passed a complete background and criminal history check. All staff have been selected for their experience, special talents, sensitivity, and creativity.

Limited scholarships are available based on financial need. Scholarship applications are available after a payment of \$5 per child per week. Initial payments can be made at your camp's facility or through the Customer Service Center. Apply early!



Registration

Registration begins Monday, January 26, 2026

There are three ways to register:

All registrations are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Accepted forms of payment: cash, check (payable to Indy Parks), Visa, MasterCard, American Express, Discover.

To secure your camper's spot, you must complete all registration forms and pay a \$15 non-refundable registration fee per registered week per child at the time of registration. The remaining balance will be due by 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday before the week of camp begins. Failure to meet the Wednesday payment deadline will result in your child's name being removed from the registration list. Note: some specialty camps require payment in full at registration.

Day Camp Refund Policy

Indy Parks will issue a full refund if the camp is canceled. All refunds could take six to eight weeks.

Bike Camp, Garfield Park Arts Center, Southeastway Park, Eagle Creek Park, and Holliday Park Refund Policy

- Notice of withdrawal must be made at least two weeks before the first day of camp. A refund will be issued, but the \$15 registration fee is non-refundable or transferrable.
- If notice of withdrawal is less than two weeks before the first day of camp, a 50% refund will be given, and the \$15 registration fee remains non-refundable or transferrable.

Traditional or GATHER Camps Refund Policy

- Notice of withdrawal must be made by the Thursday before camp begins. A refund will be issued, but the \$15 registration fee will not be refunded.

Camp withdrawals must be requested no later than the Thursday the week before the camp for a refund. If a medical emergency occurs after the two week deadline, a refund will be issued, but the \$15 registration fee will not be refunded. A written note from a physician is required for a refund in the event of a medical emergency. For COVID-19 related illnesses, at-home COVID-19 tests are acceptable.
